PURPOSE AND ROLE

- The EFRS is a non-profit organization, set up by professional societies that represent radiographers in the geographic continent of Europe (professional societies from 30 countries representing ± 100.000 radiographers).
- The role of the EFRS is to represent, promote and develop the profession of radiographers in Europe, within the whole range of medical imaging, nuclear medicine and radiotherapy.





OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To undertake all actions in order to generate influence on European policies and to negotiate with European bodies about all issues that may be of relevance for the profession.
- 2. To stimulate inter-state professional cooperation throughout Europe in scientific, technical, ethical, organizational and labor areas by facilitating the exchange of information between member societies.
- 3. To promote patient safety and radiation protection
- 4. To promote the use of the EFRS reference code of ethics
- 5. To develop European standards of professional practice
- 6. To promote evidence based practice and the principle of 'science in society'
- 7. To promote harmonization of initial and post-graduate education
- 8. To facilitate free movement of radiographers
- 9. To cooperate with other organizations with similar objectives





EFRS CODE OF ETHICS FOR RADIOGRAPHERS

Professional life

I will provide a high standard of practice and care at all times;

I will work within the limits of my competence and apply best evidence or best practice in my daily work;

I must keep my knowledge and skills up to date throughout my working life;

I must keep to a minimum the radiation exposure to the patient, myself and other persons present at the time of the examination or treatment;

I will always strive to deliver the best quality of care and treatment to all patients;

I will always ensure the proper function and use of equipment and accessories with care and based upon proper knowledge.

Relationship with patients

I will always do my best to maintain the rights and dignity of patients at all times to provide a safe and supportive environment;

I understand that information relating to patients must be treated as confidential;

I must not discriminate against any patient in any way;

I will maintain effective communication with patients during their treatment and care:

I must always be aware of the patient's individual needs and vulnerability due to their disease and will provide support as and when needed;

I understand that it is the right of all patients to be given information regarding their future imaging procedures or treatments.

Personal and professional standards

I will promote trust and confidence in the profession by my conduct in both in my personal and professional life and uphold the reputation of my profession at all times;

I must keep myself informed of developments within the profession to ensure best possible standards of care;

Whenever possible, I will support and participate in audit and research in order to provide evidence of best practice;

I will support and participate in the clinical education of radiography students to improve their understanding and knowledge of radiography practice;

I will share knowledge with others in a spirit of collegiality, fully engage in teamwork and uphold the rights of patients in all situations.






