
#### Switzerland: dose in medical diagnostic





# **Population exposure\* in medical diagnostic**







## Justification of projet


- 20% CT unjustified in Sweden (2006) Swedish Radioation Protection Agency 2009
- 30% CT unjustified in young patients in Finland (2005) Eur. Radiol. 2009
- CT: >50% patients unjustified phases in USA (2008) ACR 2011
- CT: teaching reduces dose up to 30% in CH (2009) Schindera S, Radiologe 2010
- Constant increase of CTs and CT examinations in Switzerland OFSP, CHUV






#### **Swiss legislation and activities**

To guarantee the optimal use of ionizing radiations for patients in radiology




- Justification of examinations/treatments


- Peer review system

#### **The Swiss system**


- At our request, **representative experts** have been designated from the professional associations to study the system. We continue to work with them for the legislation, guidelines, ...
- The professional **audit organisation** will be **extern** to the government.
- The auditors will be experienced and independant.
- Audited organisations will cover the costs of the audits.
- Issues due to multilingualism and multiculturalism.

# Work plan

- Official start: April 2011: public kick-off
- **System analysis** with main stakeholders in 2011 (radiologists, nuclear medicine physicians, radiooncologists, radiopharmacists, medical physicists, radiographers, patient organisations, hospitals, insurances, government)



- Modification of the legislation
- Guidelines for the good clinical praxis
- Definition of audit programs
- Definition of criteria for auditors
- Training of the auditors
- First official clinical audits: 2017
